**MISSIONARY PRAYER REQUEST:** Chris Matthews' end-of-year report starts with spreading the Word. First, he helped grow the number of believers in Cuba by offering a three-part course in Bible Leadership across the whole island to 369 students in 29 different locations. Those trained will work in leadership roles in local churches and in new house churches. Chris also offered a week-long series to seminary students at Lacy Theological Seminary on serving full-time in the Spanish- speaking world. Newly renamed Sevilla Theological Seminary has pushed the "restart" with new staff and classes and expects to grow to 50 students.
