Mother-tongue translators must memorize a source language recording and then say and record the passage in the target language. Steve did not come back converted but did pick up some ideas for improving the normal written translation process. A former student attended the same conference and while visiting the Doty's designed a process to select the preferred method, oral or written, for hearing a translation.
