MISSIONARY PRAYER REQUEST: Steve and Marjorie Doty, our Wycliffe Bible Translators in Thailand, often share some of their challenges. Marge just finished teaching another course in phonetics, where the students learn to carefully listen to the language being studied. One challenge is to determine how many bilabial sounds are used. These are sounds made with the lips together (p,b,m). The number varies with different languages and helps with classification. Steve is now evaluating computerized books for their program that help translators understand the verse being translated, which is very different from a commentary. The Doty's ask for prayer for their work.
