MISSIONARY PRAYER REQUEST: At a recent Table Talk Chris Matthews presented the importance of a huge project that he is part of to restore the San Isidoro Monastery in Spain. When completed this monastery will be the restored spiritual center for Christianity's historical development in Spain. This project has faced a funding deadline to pay the architects and Chris gave us regular updates all month. They raised 88% of the needed money by the end of August and are focused on the remaining \$10,400 for September.
