CARE AND CONCERN

MISSIONARY PRAYER REQUEST: This past Fall we received a disturbing email from Paul Sydnor, part of refugee ministry in Europe. His wife had developed Trigeminal Neuralgia, a nerve disorder, which devastated her to the point of no speech, almost non-eating, non-sleeping, bed-fast, with severe medication reactions. In their Christmas Update she is finding the medication gives her pain relief, with limited general improvement of function. They also updated their kids' news: Tessa is finishing a Master's in Religious Studies, Noah, finishing nursing school, and Luke continues with music. Paul asks for prayer for his family and for their refugee work.

Genesis 12:2-3 (NIV)
