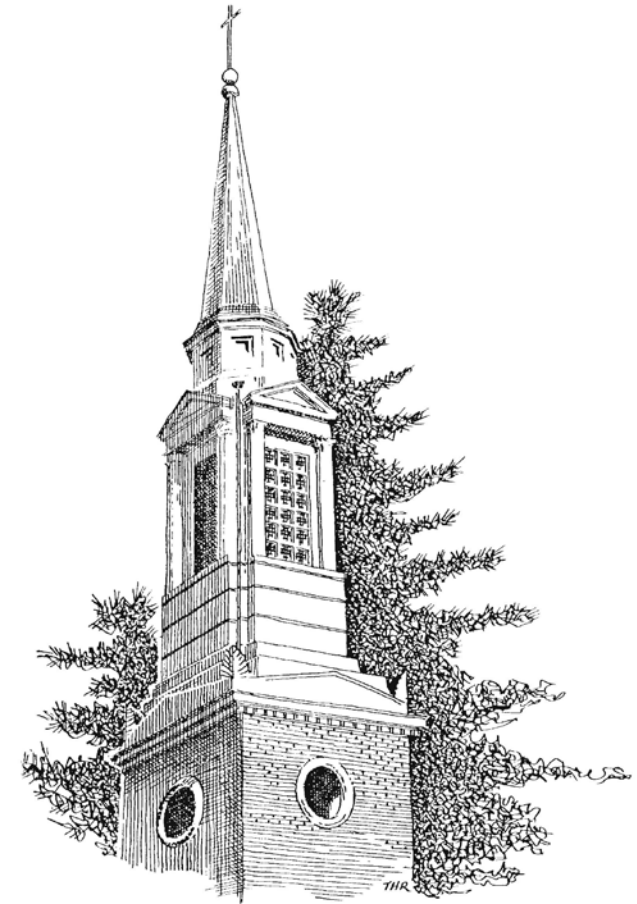

MISSIONARY PRAYER REQUEST: Chris Matthews' missionary focus has been on the need to build up the core of Spanish speaking believers in Spain. He succeeded in establishing Seville Theological Seminary in 2003 and began the investigation into re-establishing the Ancient Monastery of Seville. This could be the re-establishment of a Christian center of Protestantism comparable to Germany and England. Recently, Chris mentioned some prayer needs at the Seminary: more local professors, additional new students, and more funds for operational needs as the fall term begins. Let us pray for Chris, his calling, and the tasks the Lord has given him.
