Chapters 2-4

I. The Last Days

- A. Millennial Kingdom, Mount Zion, Mount Mariah, Temple Mount (Isaiah 2:1-5)
 - 1. Mountain of the Lord (2:2)
 - 2. People and nations will flock to this mountain (2:2)
 - 3. For worship, teaching, the Word of God, Judgment (2:3-4)
 - 4. Peace, no war (2:4)
 - 5. Israel will walk in His light (2:5)
- B. The Day of the Lord (Isaiah 2:6-22)
 - 1. Judgment for divination, superstitions, worldliness (2:6)
 - 2. Idols of riches, wealth, possessions or anything we treasure more than God, where things become our God (2:7-8)
 - 3. Men with all their pride and arrogance will be humbled (Isaiah 2:9-18)
 - 4. Mankind made arrogant with all they have accomplished, built, and the commerce they have created (2:14-16)
 - 5. Judgment so severe that men will try to hide from God (2:19-21)
 - 6. Don't trust in man and what he has made, trust in God, the Ultimate Creator (2:22)
- C. The Judgment to Come (Isaiah 3:1-4:1)
 - 1. Pervasive famine and contaminated water (3:1)
 - 2. No one will be spared (3:2-8)
 - 3. Blatant sin and defiance brings disaster on themselves (3:9)
 - 4. The wicked will turn the world upside down (3:4-6, 11-12)
 - 5. The Lord will pass judgment (3:13)
 - 6. For ruining the earth and plundering the poor (3:14-15)
 - 7. Worldly women will be judged (3:16-24)
 - 8. Men will fall in war so there are 7 women for every man (3:25-4:1)

II. The Branch of Israel, the Branch of the Lord

- A. Will restore the beauty of Israel (Isaiah 4:2-4)
 - 1. Israel will accept their Messiah (4:2-3)
 - 2. He will pour out His Holy Spirit to cleanse hearts (4:4)
- B. Will protect and shelter Israel (Isaiah 4:5-6)
 - 1. Will be a pillar of smoke by day and pillar of fire by night (4:5)
 - 2. Provide shelter, shade, and a refuge (4:6)
