After a long season of prayer and discernment, the Elders sensed God's leading and have decided to cancel all in-person worship services through the end of January 2021. We will still be livestreaming the 11:00 am service, but with the spike in Covid cases within our community, we discerned it best to not meet in person for the next few weeks.

As such, we are asking you to help us with three things:

1. To help pray for the leaders of the church. They have had to make some difficult decisions which the church has never had to face before. We are practicing Adaptive Change in ministry right now, and it is difficult. Please pray for our elders during this time of leadership.
2. Please help us communicate to others you know that might not check this email and let them know we will be online Sundays at 11:00 am, but not in person. We hope to be back in person as February begins. That will make for a joyous time!
3. Also, we are asking you to prayerfully consider continuing your generosity to the Church as we move into the first month of a new year. Even though we will not be meeting in person, we will still be joining together as the Body of Christ and desire to be good stewards of all that God is entrusting to us.

I know this will be difficult for everyone to support, but the elders were unanimous on this decision. As a matter of fact, this is the first time that the elders have voted unanimously concerning worship since Covid began spreading throughout the United States. Unity is a beautiful thing!

So, there will be no King Street Worship service in person and no 11:00 am worship service in person beginning this weekend.
