The Trinity Bible Study Class is studying the New Testament "Book of Hebrews:

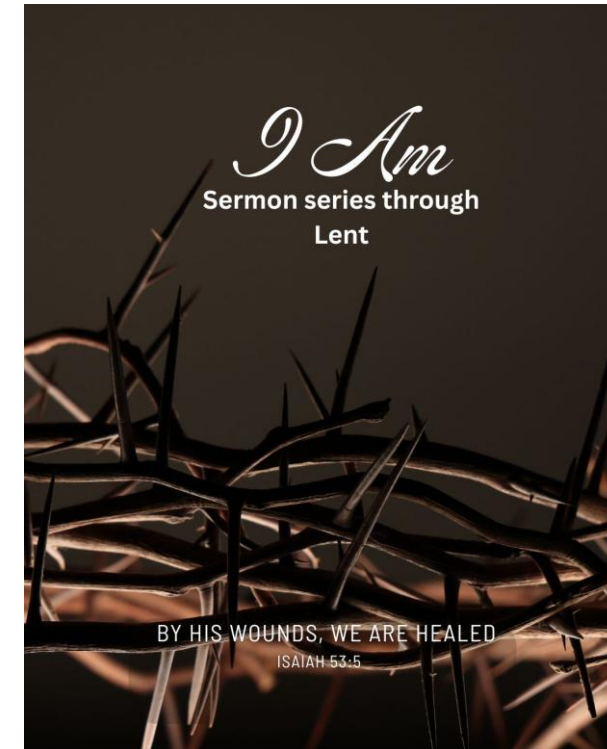
