Adult Sunday school meets at 9:30 am.

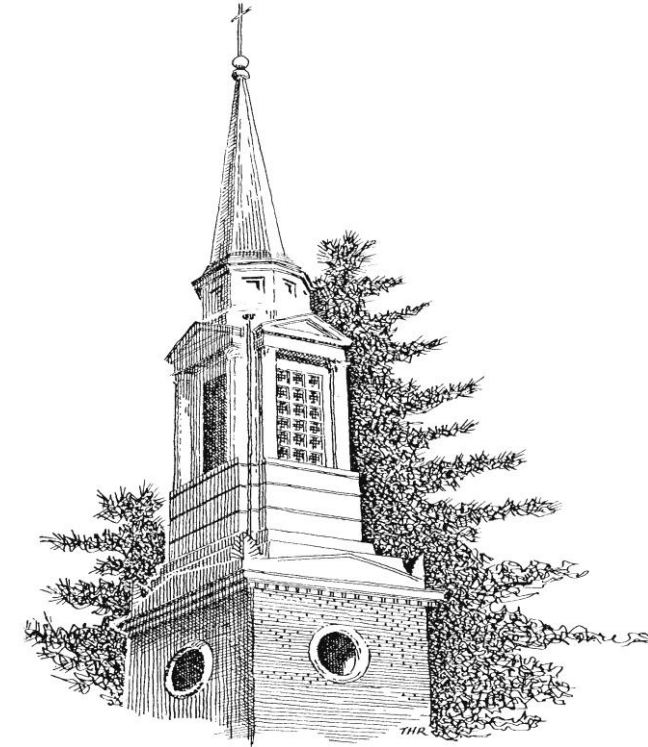

Bluegrass Bash

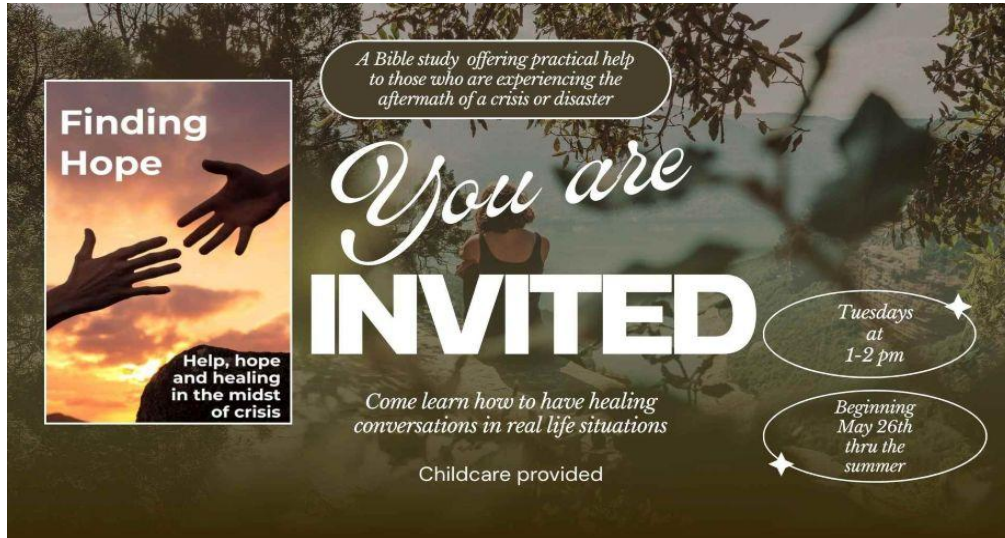
