6th-12th grade youth meet each Sunday at 9:00 am in the upstairs youth rooms for food, fun, and fellowship.


SUNDAY SCHOOL:

William Temple states that normal Christians experience 3 conversion experiences in their life:

- 1. Conversion to Christ (Receptive to Him)**
- 2. Conversion to the People of Christ – the Church (Mental Assent)**
- 3. Conversion to the Mission of Christ in the World (Total Surrender)**
