**Missionary Prayers**

Paul Sydnor has two major announcements. He is stepping away from his local ministry position in Lille but continuing with his refugee ministry to asylum seekers. This is coupled with a leave of absence for several months to visit supporters. Paul continues to represent refugee issues in the Global Diaspora Group of the Lausanne Movement. He will be involved in preparing for the Fourth Lausanne Congress bringing 5000 people together in September in Seoul, S. Korea and is the primary writer for a paper to be presented there. His second announcement is the arrival of the third grandchild in December.
