The Shorter Catechism Class meets in Room 208 and is currently studying The Shorter Catechism.

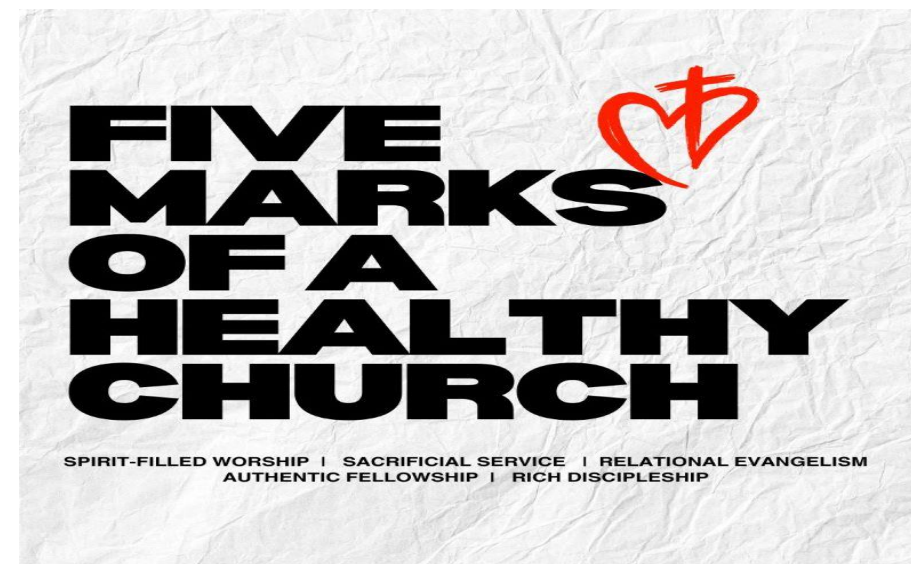
The Local Church Compassion Ministry Class meets in the Parlor and is currently studying the book of James.
