The Shorter Catechism Class meets in Room 208 and is currently studying Shorter Catechism.

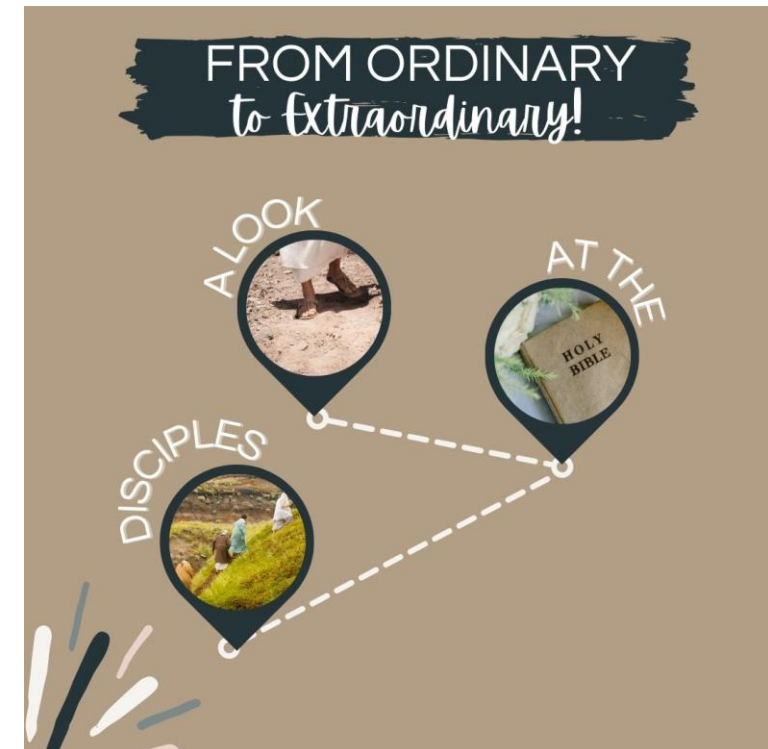
The Local Church Compassion Ministry Class meets in the Parlor and is currently studying Beatitudes.
