The Trinity Class meets in Room 210 and is currently studying a series on the Attributes of God, based on the book, "Knowing God" by evangelist J. I. Packer.

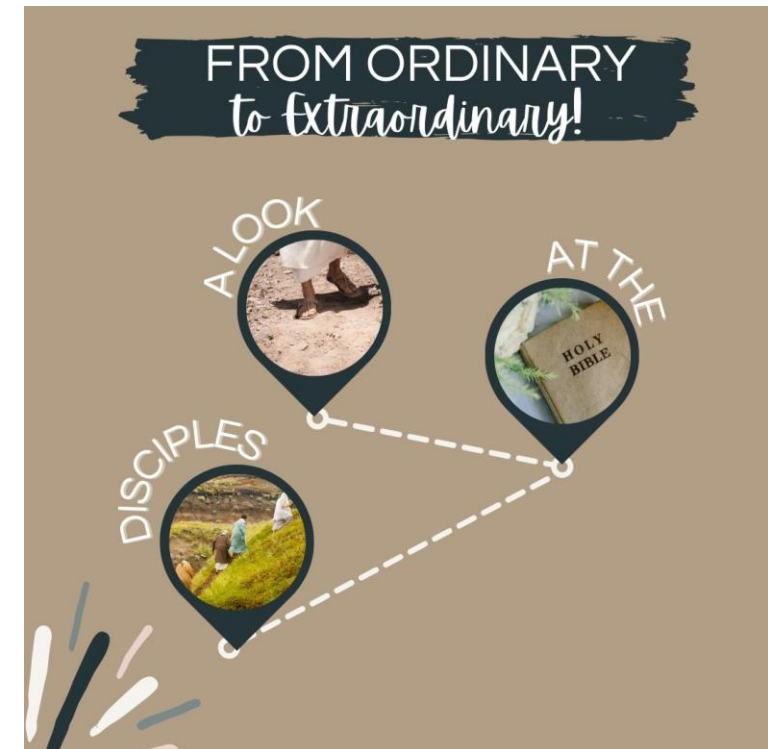
The Shorter Catechism Class meets in Room 208 and is currently studying Shorter Catechism.
