Pennies for Shoeboxes

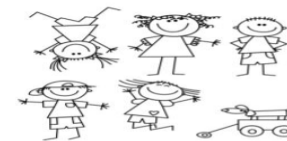
The “Pennies for Shoeboxes” collection will be held November 12th prior to the services so please bring your pennies (we do accept other coins, paper money & checks).
