He is involved with the executive team of the Lausanne movement which had its recent meeting in Korea where over 5000 people from 205 countries met. The Lausanne movement focuses on people on the move called the Global Diaspora Network. They are telling others about God's work with these people. Dr. Sydnor co-founded the Refugee Highway Partnership in Europe. This group is a network for refugee ministries focused on forcibly displaced people. He seeks your prayers.
