

John Hanna had news from the Urbana Missions Conference, North America's largest student missions conference, held in Indianapolis, Indiana. This conference had an undergirding of intercessory prayer beginning over a year before it started with an intercessory prayer effort going 24/7 during the entire four-day conference. There were over 5,500 attending. They were offered multilingual speakers, scripture study conversations, next steps coaching among many other topics. Over 350 surrendered to Christ.
