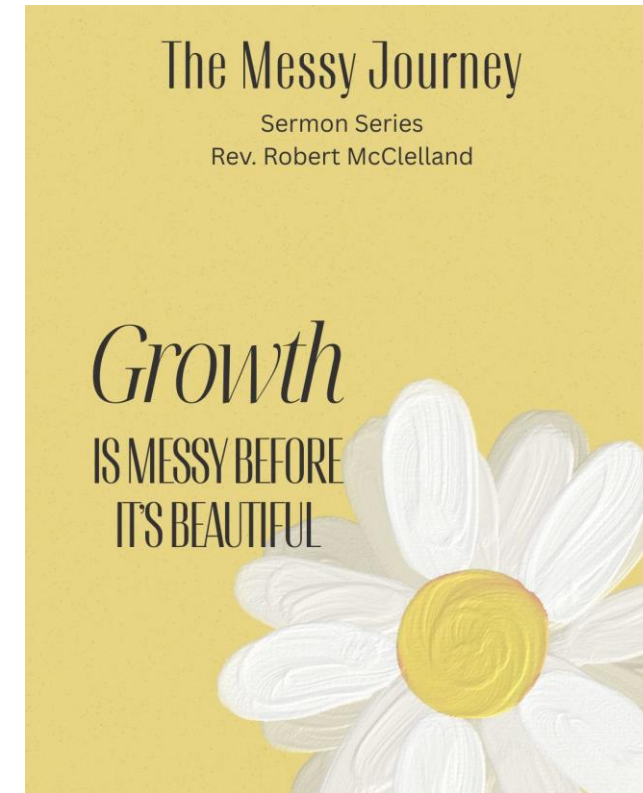
The Shorter Catechism Class meets in Room 208 and is currently studying Shorter Catechism.
