The Shorter Catechism Class meets in Room 208 and is currently studying Shorter Catechism.

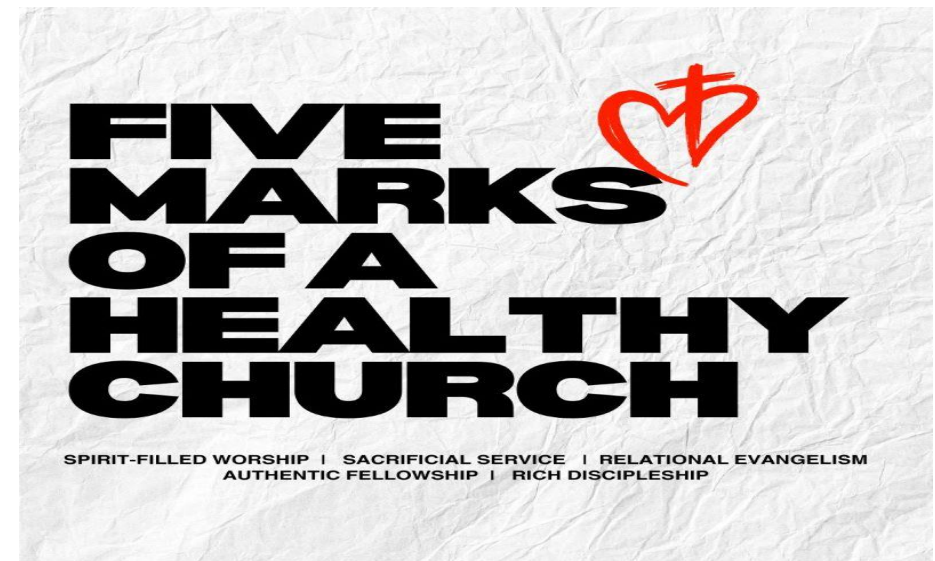
The Local Church Compassion Ministry Class meets in the Parlor and is currently studying the Rose Book of Discipleship.

Mission Partner Update

Shawn Stewart is a Missions Mobilizer with World Outreach, the missions arm of the EPC. He recently returned from the Mid-Winter Mission Outreach in Fremont, CA, with Missions Cohort 6 (MC6), a group of young adults who have felt called to global missions. They reached out to families from around the world, inviting them into gospel conversations. He then shared at 2 Presbytery meetings to connect local congregations with Mission partners on the field. From Shawn:

How You Can Pray

- Divine Connections: That I would have meaningful conversations and meet individuals who feel called to global missions.
- Response to the Call: That God would stir hearts to respond—whether through prayer, financial support, short-term trips, or long-term missions in hard-to-reach places.
- Kingdom Fruit: That these presentations would inspire collaboration among churches and lead to real, tangible impact for UPGs, both locally and globally.
- New Laborers for the Harvest: That God might raise up one or two individuals willing to go long-term to serve in these hard places.
