The Shorter Catechism Class meets in Room 208 and is currently studying Shorter Catechism.


The Local Church Compassion Ministry Class meets in the Parlor and is currently studying the Rose Book of Discipleship.

# **Philippians Philippians 2:19-30**

To believe in holy catholic church
The word, catholic means –
Three Missionaries of the Early Church:

Three Missionaries of Our Church:
The Point:  When there is a continuous flow back and forth between the mission field and the church, churches are healthy and faithful, and missionaries are encouraged and effective.  Churches are healthy and faithful when it learns how to receive missionaries coming back off the field for a season, a furlough, etc.

- 2 Prayers to join in praying:
  - 1. Pray that God would raise up 50 people from HPC in the next three years to engage locally, nationally, or globally with God's work. May it be an outward movement of the church caused by an inward motivation of the Gospel.
  - 2. Pray, "Lord, are you calling me to be one of those missionaries?" Actually, don't pray that. Because the answer is yes. Pray, "Lord, may I be motivated by the Gospel enough to move outward, and be obedient in love when that happens."
