Is He Risen?

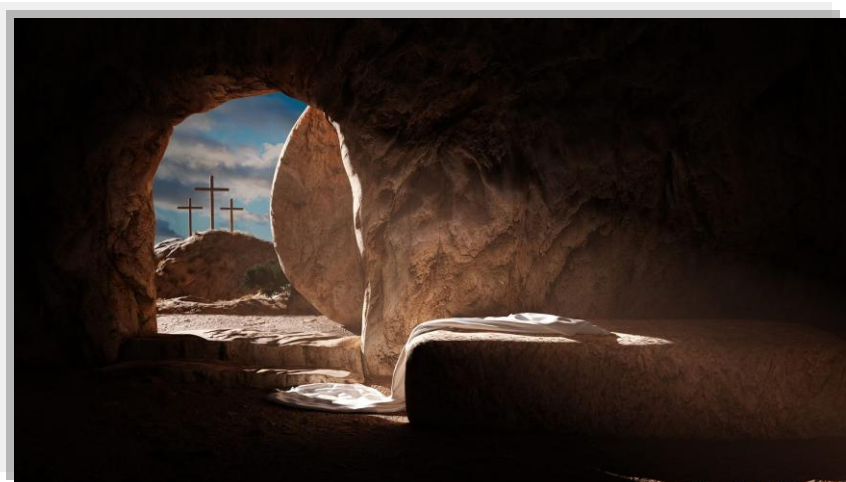

Prayer of Confession

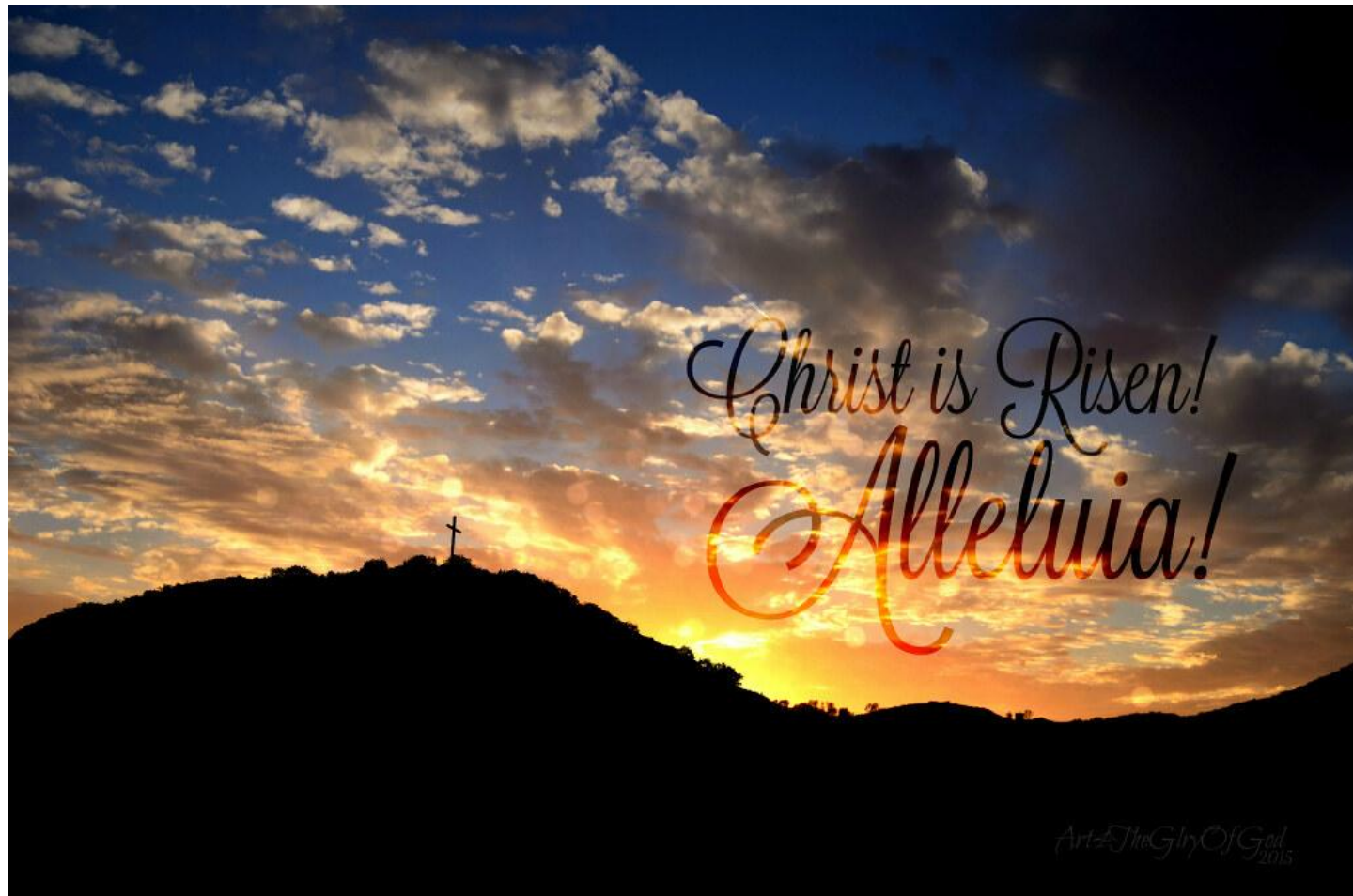
