

Chris Matthews just sent his update. First, he will be meeting soon with the Spanish duke who owns one third of the monastery San Isidoro del Campo in Santiponce, Spain. This is the next step in a plan to establish a seminary using the old monastery. Second, Chris went to Guam as a board member of Pacific Islands University to witness the graduation of forty-four Chuukese pastors. The next week Typhoon Mawar went through the island and destroyed the university's administration buildings. There will be a major campaign to rebuild the damaged buildings. They ask for prayer for this project.
