





A Great Year for Child Evangelism Fellowship and School Clubs!





The Greater Asheville Chapter of CEF serves 6 counties: Buncombe, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Madison, and Transylvania. In 2024, CEF reached over 3300 people with the Gospel, and more than 2000 of those were children. There were 298 decisions for Christ. By the end of the 2024-25 school year, our CEF Chapter was sharing the Gospel in 26 After School Good News Clubs (GNC).

We have plans to add 4 to 6 more schools next Fall. Our church sponsors a team of adults that leads a weekly GNC at both Upward (on Tuesday) and Edneyville (on Thursday) Elementary Schools. Our team saw growth in our students as they asked questions, sang songs, learned memory verses, and shared prayer requests. A total of 15 children made decisions to trust Jesus as Savior!! Glory to God!

There are many ways to partner with this exciting gospel-centered ministry. Your may serve on a club team, pray for our team members and students, provide money for snacks, prepare takehome bags, or financially support CEF.


