Hello Fall!

Recently there have been a few interesting inquiries about the library collection of Bibles. I decided to ask an educated Sunday School teacher what Bibles he would recommend to add to the Bible section.

We now have Bibles in the library in the King James Version, and several NIV, like the pew Bibles. I am looking for others to add.

The suggested additions would be the RSV, Revised Standard Version, the New Jerusalem Bible, and the New English Bible or REB. Another suggestion was the Legacy Standard Bible. These inquiries about Bibles were for suggestions to give as a gift, or a version to use for a Women's Bible Study, and another for use by a Sunday School teacher to study for a class comparison. If the library adds these translations it will greatly enhance our Bible collection.

If you would like to donate a Bible of those suggested, please see the librarian on Sunday. You may have a Bible collection in your home library to donate.

And, while you are in the church library, check out a book! There are over 4000 books to choose from in many Christian categories of nonfiction and fiction too.

Local Outreach: Refuge Retreat


Refuge Retreat is a non-profit organization headquartered in Hendersonville. Their ministry is to witness and minister to college students around the country. The mission is that every college student they reach will live out the Gospel of Jesus.

The ministry was founded and is operated by Adam and Caitlin Neal. Caitlin has a child in HPC's Creative Beginnings pre-school. HPC has helped support Refuge Retreat for approximately three years.

The ministry involves organizing retreats twice a year for college students. One is in Mills River and the other is in eastern North Carolina. Up to 95 college students from 32 universities and 51 leaders gather together to worship, study God's Word, pray, and share with each other, issues in their lives. In between the retreats, the leaders stay in contact with attendees, as well as invite new students to become involved.

Plans for 2025 include introducing four weekend Micro-retreats that would involve 15-20 students and give an opportunity to disciple students on a more personal level.
