He also took the opportunity, since we were examining our new officers as they take up their duties, to talk about the session's responsibilities.

We were happy to welcome our new class of officers—everyone passed their exam! Due to the unusual and difficult situation this fall we are two months late and two elders short in getting our new year's session up and running. For a few years, we have had 12 elders—this year, only 10. Our committees are Facilities, Finance, Personnel, Local Outreach, Global Mission, and Discipleship.

Session created a new Disaster Relief Disbursement Task Force to oversee the disbursement of the approximately \$100,000 in funds donated to our church for those needing help in the aftermath of Helene. Pastor Rob has been overseeing anything up to \$1,000 and bringing larger amounts to the session for approval. The task force, chaired by Sherri Jones, has authority up to \$10,000 and for anything above, they will make recommendations to the session. This will make expenditures less cumbersome and slow for those in need.

The Discipleship Committee is starting a new Lenten Season six-week series of small groups. The groups will meet Wednesday evening from 6:30-8:00 on March 12 through April 16. Topics, teachers, and sign-ups are available at the church and on our website.
