Ministering to Others:

I. Through Thanksgiving

(Colossians 1:3-8)

II. Through Prayer

(Colossians 1:9-14)

A. Continuously to fill with

- 1. Knowledge
- 2. Spiritual Wisdom
- 3. Understanding God's will

B. A Walk Pleasing to God

(Colossians 1:10-14)

- 1. Bearing fruit in every good work
- 2. Growing in the knowledge of God
- 3. Being strengthened in His power
- 4. Joyfully giving thanks to the Father because of:
 - a. Our inheritance of God's Kingdom of light,
 - b. Our deliverance from the kingdom of darkness,
 - c. Our redemption and release from the bondage of sin into the freedom of grace.

III. Through the Power of Christ Jesus

(Colossians 1:15-19, Romans 8:26-27, John 17:20-26)

Who is:

A. The image of the invisible God,

(Colossians 1:15)

B. The creator of the universe (live for Him, not for self with its emotional ups and downs), (Colossians 1:15-17, John 10:10)

C. The head of the body (He has complete supremacy over the church and over us). (Colossians 1:18-19)

Other religions are about man seeking God, Christianity is about God seeking us.

Reconciled by Christ to present us holy through Him, without blemish, free from accusation. (John 8:1-11)

But God calls us to three responsibilities when we minister to others:

IV. Through taking our responsibility seriously

(Colossians 1:21-23)

A. Three responsibilities

- 1. Continue in our faith, believe
- 2. Established and firm, our faith should shine (Matthew 5:14-16)
- 3. Not moved from the hope of the gospel, our faith should persevere
 - a. Stable in our position
 - b. Not misled by every whim or doctrine that comes along

B. And God gives us three reasons to be obedient to the three responsibilities

- We have heard and experienced the gospel, so this faith is **personal**
 - a. We know its power
 - b. Know its reality, it is not fake
 - c. It is not a religion, it is a personal relationship with the living God
- 2. Gospel proclaimed universally to every creature and culture, so this faith is **practical** (See also Colossians 1:6)
- 3. Gospel brings miraculous conversions like Paul, so this faith is **profound**, life changing
