Three is the number of completeness:

- 1. Three Rounds
- 2. Three children

Shear-Jashub ("a remnant will return"), son of Isaiah: refers to Babylonian return and end time return to Israel=Current & Future Maher-Shalal-Hash-Baz ("quick to plunder"), son of Isaiah: quick plunder of Syria, Ephraim by Assyria=Current Immanuel ("God with us"), son of David: setting up Millennial Kingdom=

Current & future

- 3a. Three nations: Syria, Israel, Assyria=Current
- 3b. Three more nations: Assyria (conquer Israel), Babylon (conquer Judah, remnant return), Future "Babylon" (end time, remnant return) = Future

Round One: The Threat to Test

- 1. Syria (Aram) and Israel plot against Judah (Isaiah 7:1-6)
- 2. Not going to happen (Isaiah 7:7-9)
- 3. Sign of Immanuel (Isaiah 7:10-15)
- 4. Before 16 years Syria and Israel laid waste by Assyria (Isaiah 7:16-17)

Round Two: The Judgment of Judah

- 1. Assyria will devastate Judah (Isaiah 7:18-25)
- 2. Sign of Maher-Shalel-Hash-Baz, "quick to plunder", before speak Syria and Israel carried off by Assyria (Isaiah 8:1-4)
- 3. To preserve Immanuel, Judah and David's line would not be obliterated, Assyria advances to the neck of Judah but not the head=Jerusalem (Isaiah 8:5-8)
- 4. Assyria will not succeed, God's grace will be manifested in Immanuel(God with us v10) (Isaiah 8:9-10)
- 5. Satan devise strategy against God's elect but twarted by Immanuel (Isaiah 8:10)
- 6. Immanuel a sanctuary for those who believe and a stumbling stone (1 Peter 2:7-8) to the unfaithful, rebellious and those who reject Immanuel (Isaiah 8:11-15)
- 7. Wait only on God (Isaiah 8:16-18)
- 8. Trust only in the authority of the word of God, not in any other authority such as mediums, spiritists, or consulting the dead (Isaiah (8:19-20)

- 9. Roam through life and land famished for God's word, cursing God, seeking worldly, earthly things finding only utter darkness (Isaiah 8:21-22)
- 10. Believers see great light of Immanuel (Isaiah 9:1-2)
- 11. Immanuel as liberator (Isaiah 9:3-5)
- 12. Immanuel as great leader and Lord (Isaiah 9:6-7)

Round One Redux: Result of Rejection

1. Israel/Ephraim judged and doomed and as in end times they still will not believe and return to God (v13), God will cut off Israel (Isaiah 9:8-21, 10:1-4)

Round Two Redux: Assyria Averted

- 1. Assyria plunders Judah and eventual punishment of Assyria before they take Jerusalem (Isaiah 10:5-19)
- 2. 185,000 men put to death by angel (Isaiah 37:36) (Isaiah 10:16)
- 3. Remnant returns, Shear-Jashub, after Babylonian captivity and in end time (Isaiah 10:20-23)
- 4. Do not fear Assyrians (Isaiah 10:24-27)
- 5. Assyria makes fearful advance into Judah but will be stopped at Jerusalem by God (Isaiah 10:28-32)
- 6. Sudden end to Assyria, army cut down (Isaih 37:36) (Isaiah 10:33-34)

Round Three: The Savior from the Stump

- 1. Immanuel from stump of Jesse, a shoot from the truncated stump of Jesse, stump of Jesse=David (Isaiah 11:1)
- 2. Immanuel full of the Sevenfold Holy Spirit of God (Rev 1:4, 4:5, 5:6) (Prov. 9 seven pillars of wisdom, James 3:17) (Isaiah 11:2)
- 3. Immanuel (God with us) millennial kingdom Equitable, Immanuel means God with us which is all about the millennial kingdom with God (Jesus) living among us (Isaiah 11:3-5)
- 4. Immanuel brings total peace in millennial kingdom (Isaiah 11:6-9)
- 5. Immanuel unites Jews and Gentiles in millennial kingdom (Isaiah 11:10)
- 6. Immanuel will regather the Jews for a second time in millennial kingdom (after Babylon will be the first) (Isaiah 11:11-16)
- 7. Song of Praise in millennial kingdom (Isaiah 12:1-6)
